School Schedules

GRADE 5-6 SCHOOL

The school schedule at our Grade 5-6 school will have seven periods and include double instructional blocks of 80 minutes for Mathematics and English Language Arts (Reading, Writing, Speaking, and Listening). Social Studies and Science classes will meet 40 minutes per day, and students will take two 40 minute elective courses each trimester. All students in grades 5 and 6 will take Physical Education, Health, Music, Band, Chorus, Art, Digital Literacy, and Computer Science over the course of the year.

GRADE 7-8 SCHOOL

The school schedule at our Grade 7-8 school will have seven periods. Students will have a double instructional block of English Language Arts (Reading, Writing, Speaking, and Listening). All students in grades 7 and 8 will take Physical Education, Health, and Computers and Digital Literacy. Students will also be able to take Music, Band, Chorus, Art, Tech Ed, and Spanish in grades 7 and 8. In addition, a workgroup of stakeholders will be created in the fall of 2018 to look at alternative scheduling options for the 2019-2020 school year.

TRANSITION UPDATES

NAMING OF SCHOOLS

Please join us for an Education and Planning Subcommittee Meeting on April 23, 2018 at 6:00 p.m. in the auditorium at South Middle School. Options and procedures for naming our new Grade 5-6 and Grade 7-8 schools will be explored and reviewed.

SCHOOL TIMES

For the 2018-2019 school year, Fort Meadow Early Childhood Center will continue to operate from 9:00 a.m. – 3:00 p.m. There will also be no change to the high school start and end time (7:15 a.m. – 1:56 p.m.). Both the grade 5-6 and grade 7-8 schools will begin at 8:00 a.m. and end at 2:29 p.m., the same as our current middle school schedule. In fact, the only change to school times will be at the elementary school level. School will begin fifteen minutes later at 9:15 a.m. and students will get out at 3:15 p.m., also fifteen minutes later. This change was made to allow our buses more time to complete their afternoon runs. It will also save the district over \$250,000 in additional busing costs. WPS will be working with the YMCA and Boys and Girls Club to expand before school programming to assist parents with this change. More information will be shared as it becomes available.

INTRA-DISTRICT TRANSFERS

Westfield Public Schools will honor existing elementary school intra-district transfers. New grade K-4 intra-district transfers for the 2018-2019 school year will only be considered for siblings and extenuating circumstances. ENGLISH LANGUAGE LEARNERS

The closing of Russell Elementary School and district transition plans have created a change for our elementary English Learners (ELs). Next year, Highland will no longer be the only elementary site to service ELs. The district is expanding the English Learner Education (ELE) Program to include a second site in order to more efficiently serve the needs of our growing population. EL students that live in the Abner Gibbs, Munger Hill, Paper Mill, and Southampton Road regions of the city will now attend Munger Hill Elementary School. STEP UP DAY



ONLINE REGISTRATION

We look forward to partnering with you to provide you a comprehensive education experience that prepares your child for a bright future. Kindergarten Registration will take on a new look this school year, as Westfield is moving to electronic registration for the 2018-19 school year. Directions for accessing electronic registration can be found on the Westfield Public Schools District Webpage at www.schoolsofwestfield.org. To access the online registration form, click the *Parents* link at the top of the page and then click on the *Registration* link. Online registration will be available beginning on **Wednesday, April 11, 2018**. Families wishing to enroll Kindergarten students are asked to complete the online registration form. In addition to completing the online form, the following documents should be submitted to your child's school: Birth Certificate, Complete Immunization/Health Records, Proof of Westfield Address, Current IEP (Individual Education Plan) or 504 Documents, if applicable, and Proof of Custody, if applicable. According to Massachusetts law, only those students who are living in Westfield are eligible to attend the Westfield Public Schools unless accepted through the School Choice Program. If you require assistance with completing the registration process or have any questions, please contact us at 413-642-9320.

EARLY RELEASE DAYS

The last day of school for the 2017-2018 school year is June 21, 2018. This was already a scheduled early release day for students. State law requires that all schools be in session for 180 days. In order to provide our teachers with time to prepare for our transition and resulting moves, June 19 and 20 have been added early release days for students. High school students will be dismissed at 11:00 a.m., middle school students at 11:30 a.m., and elementary school students at 12:00 p.m.
